DAILY CLEANING

- Empty and clean the crumb tray.
- Clean the conveyor belt.
- Wipe the exterior with a cloth, then rinse it with clean water.

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE STEPS

- Remove the following components: baffles, conveyor, end panels, finger panels, and air returns. Move the fingers one section at a time!
- Clean both the oven's interior and the air intake on the exterior.
- **3.** Clean the components using mild detergents, rinse them thoroughly, and dry them.
- 4. Apply the pretreatment oven coating.
- Replace all components.
- 6. Clean the exterior of the oven.



The #1 cause of electrical component failure is overheating caused by grease and dust. This can be prevented by wiping the air intakes on the front and back daily.
